



The Angus Campbell Award For Excellence in the Field of Addictions

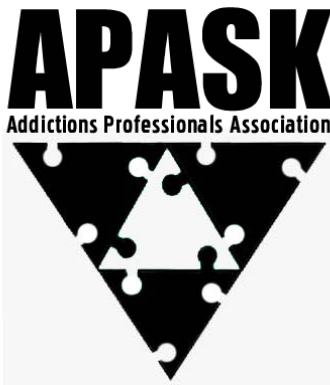
The Saskatchewan Addictions Interagency Conference Planning Committee has approved the creation of an award to recognize outstanding contributions made to the Addictions Field.

Suggested Nomination Criteria:

(Nominees are not required to be APASK Members)

1. Describe innovative programs developed and/or implemented by the nominee.
2. List published papers, articles, books, and pamphlets written or contributed to by the nominee for the benefit of the profession, clients or other health care workers and/or the general public.
3. Summarize ways in which the nominee demonstrated leadership in the area of service delivery.
4. List leadership roles assumed by the nominee within the addictions field such as offices held, committee involvement, special assignments, etc.
5. Identify contributions made by the nominee to the promotion of overall holistic health and human services.
6. Identify contributions in other areas deemed appropriate for this award (personal achievements post-diploma credentials, volunteer history and community involvement, etc.)
7. Summarize the nominee's contribution to:
 - a) The furtherance of goals, objectives and activities of the Addictions Field.
 - b) Other health care associations

The Angus Campbell Award for Excellence in the field of Addictions may be awarded posthumously.
